### Late, absent, or emergency!

### Non-emergency:

Our teachers have provided you with their personal cell phone numbers to be used to communicate information during class time (if you child will be absent, late or need an early pick-up). If you have a pressing question or would like to arrange a time to speak with your teacher, please use email. The teachers will respond in a timely manner. We all want to be able to devote our evenings and weekends to our families and loved ones.

Please let Val or Laura know your arrangements in advance if:

- Your child will be away for an appointment
- Your child is going away on a holiday
- Your child will be going home with a friend or another family member



# Your Child's Health

Please feel free to contact the teacher about personal medical concerns. To assist in the smooth operation of our program, we develop, review and revise policies on a regular basis. These are in a binder in the classroom.

#### **Medications:**

The teachers are not responsible for the administration of medications. Should your child require medicine, they should be removed from the classroom briefly. Please inform the teacher of any medication and possible side effects. For severe chronic medical conditions, the teacher may administer medication following a meeting to clarify details. If you require further information on this matter. please contact Lisa Saelhof @ 403-816-4095.

#### **Communicable Diseases:**

To protect the health of our children, staff, and families, please inform the teacher if your child contracts one of the following communicable diseases:

COVID-19, Chicken Pox, Influenza, Head Lice, Impetigo, Measles, Mumps, Pink Eye, Rubella, or Whopping Cough.

Please note that if the CBE (Calgary Board of Education) schools are closed for any reason (i.e. snow storm, etc.), our kindergarten will also be

suspended. Please listen to the radio and/or TV reports for detailed information.

If the kindergarten alone is affected (i.e. water main break) we will contact you via email and/or text message. You can also contact Lisa Saelhof for specifics (403-249-5275).

For your child's safety, please inform Val, Laura or Lisa if there are any changes to your email address, phone numbers, child-care arrangements, or custody orders. These will be added to the *Emergency Notification System* list.
